INTRODUCTION TO SEMS/NIMS

This two and one half hour class presents specific procedures to be used in preparing for, and responding to school emergencies. It will also help you to plan and identify your school's emergency response teams and define the roles and responsibilities of team members. Remember, State law mandates the use of the Standardized Emergency Management System (SEMS) and the National Incident Management System (NIMS) during an emergency.

After the SEMS class, participants will move into the disaster simulator to solve some real – world challenges.
