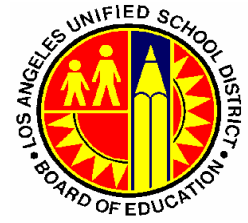




# FIRE SAFETY EDUCATION PRESENTATION



## FIRE FATALITY REDUCTIONS IN THE HOME

PRESENTED BY THE LOS ANGELES FIRE DEPARTMENT

The L.A Fire Department is offering a Community-Based Fire Fatality Reduction assembly presentation to LAUSD schools in the City of Los Angeles. The presentation can be scaled from one to two hours in order to meet the needs of the school or non-schools.

The program is presented by uniformed Los Angeles Firefighters, and is designed to stimulate and educate students and teachers about the top five fire-safety topics most frequently identified with home fire deaths:

*SMOKE  
ALARMS*

*ESCAPE  
PLANS*

*CHILD FIRE  
SAFETY*

*OLDER ADULT FIRE SAFETY  
BOTH COOKING AND HEATING*

*CARELESS  
SMOKING*

It consists of a short (ten slide) PowerPoint presentation, "Fire Safety in the Home" literature (in English and Spanish), and a visit from your local "Neighborhood Fire Station". The program is particularly significant following a catastrophic fire where loss of life or injury has occurred.
