## DISASTER AWARENESS CLASS FOR LAUSD SCHOOLS AND OFFICES

The L.A. City Fire Department is offering a "Disaster Awareness Class" to schools and offices in the City of Los Angeles. This class can be scaled from one to three hours in order to meet the needs of the school or non-school.

The program is a 1 to 3 hour course (you decide) designed to stimulate and educate employees with a general interest in disaster preparedness. This training provides a positive platform for employees and citizens to follow up with our CERT Program if they decide to increase their personal preparedness .



This course is modeled after the Fire Department's very successful Community Emergency Response Training (CERT) Program. They recognize the time challenge some employees and citizens have in completing the more extensive 17½ hour CERT Program, and they have designed the Disaster Awareness Class to meet their needs while still working to prepare the community.

The goal is to initiate and educate the public about emergency preparedness and threats to their safety and property.
