### *Basic Aid Training (BAT) Instructional Materials Make It Easy*

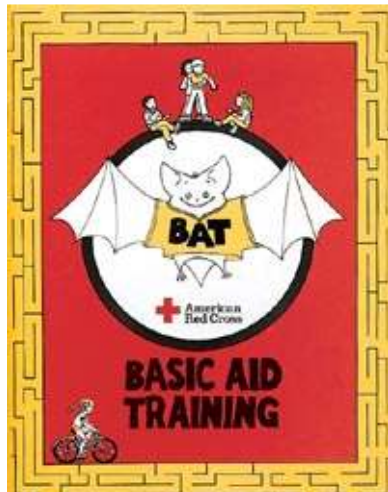
A workbook includes coloring, puzzles, mazes and word games.

Mandatory units for American Red Cross BAT certification require approximately six hours of class time. The training is flexible and can be divided over multiple class days.

Instructors will be certified California Safe Corps members. Class size ratio is 1 teacher to every 15 students
