LAUSD STATEMENT REGARDING THE IMPACT OF TODAY'S EARTHQUAKE

LOS ANGELES (July 29, 2008)—As of 3:50 p.m. today, Los Angeles Unified School District (LAUSD) officials had not received any reports of injuries to students and staff. At this hour, plant managers and school site staff at all schools in operation were still conducting school safety inspections as a precaution. All LAUSD schools, adult education centers and summer programs will be open tomorrow. Adult education and career tech centers will also remain open as scheduled this evening.

The LAUSD dismissed students attending summer school at their normal time of 12:30 p.m. Students attending year-round schools were evacuated to a safe place at the time of the earthquake. Additionally, District officials announced that all after-school programs will remain open.

Minutes after the earthquake, LAUSD officials activated the Emergency Operations Center, from where they have continued to monitor and review information from school sites throughout the day.
